






Q.2. How likely are you to attend a future conference?




Q.3. Which was your favorite session or speaker at the conference?

Feedback: All sessions were highly appreciated by the delegates, especially Women Empowerment to fight cancer.


Q.4. Which session or speaker did you least enjoy at the conference?

Feedback: All sessions were highly informative and enjoyed by the delegates.


Q.5. Were the conference facilities (venue, technology, etc.) satisfactory?



Q.6. Did you find the conference schedule and agenda easy to follow?




Q.7. Did you network with other attendees at the conference? If yes, did you find the networking opportunities helpful?
