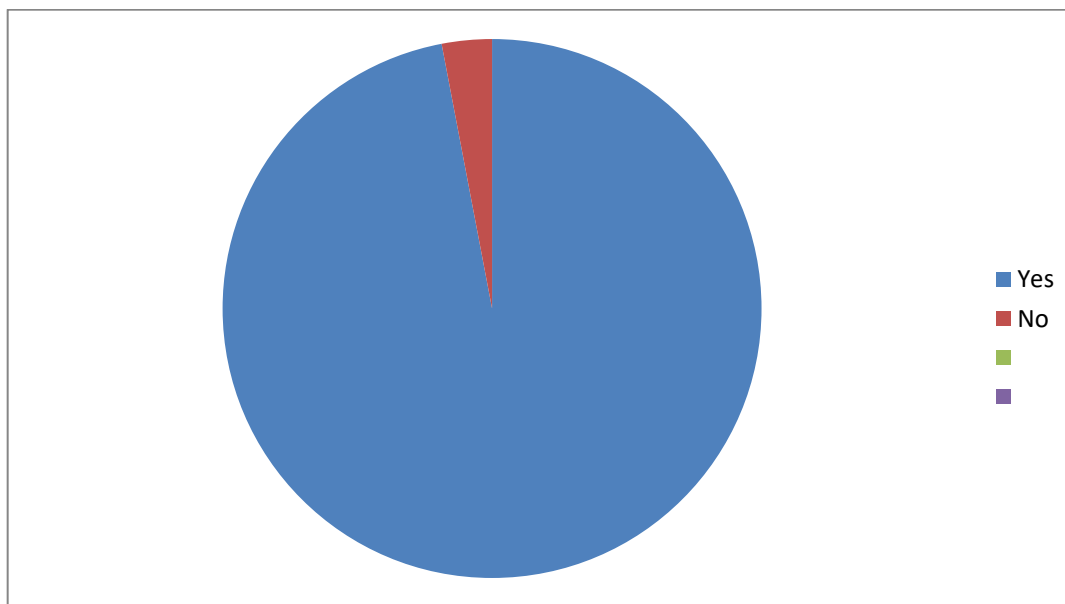

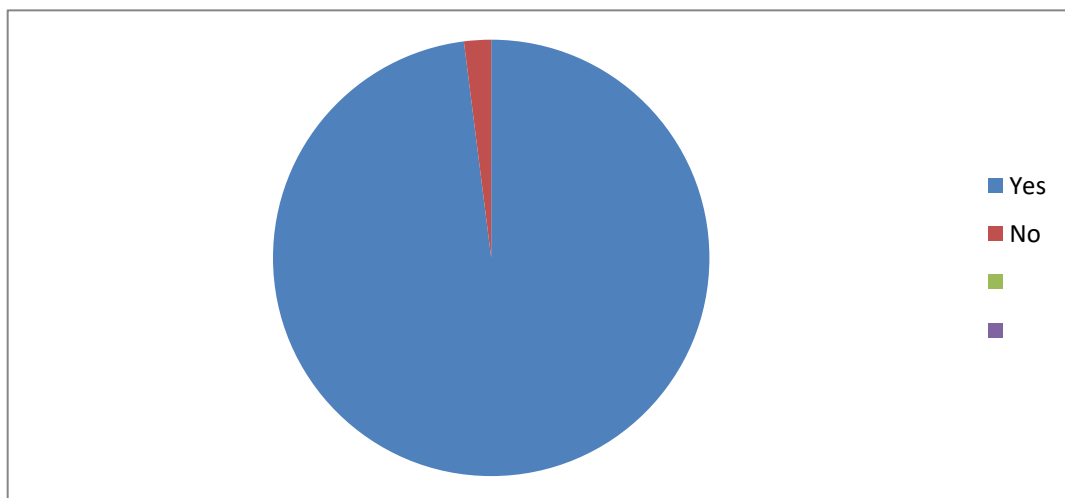
**Q.4. Which session or speaker did you least enjoy at the conference?**

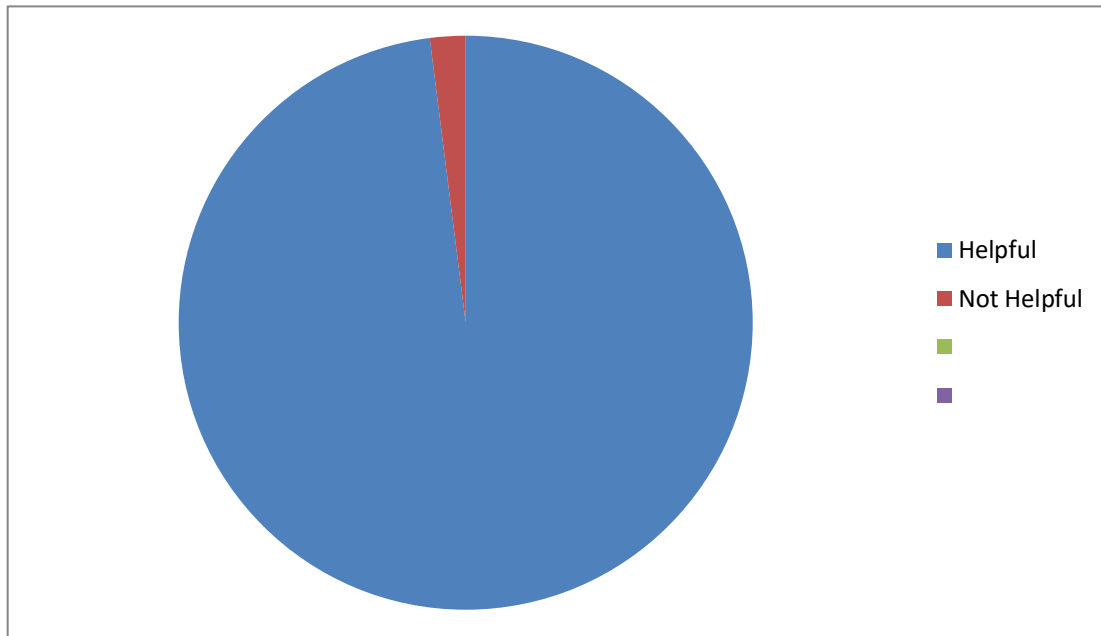

**Q.6. Did you find the conference schedule and agenda easy to follow?**



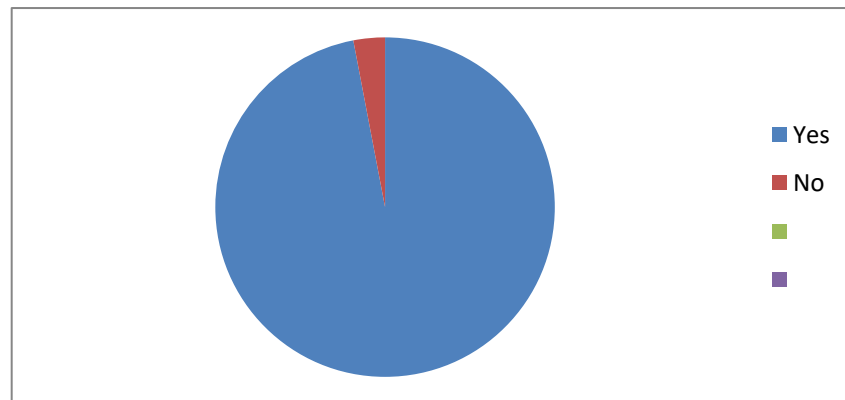

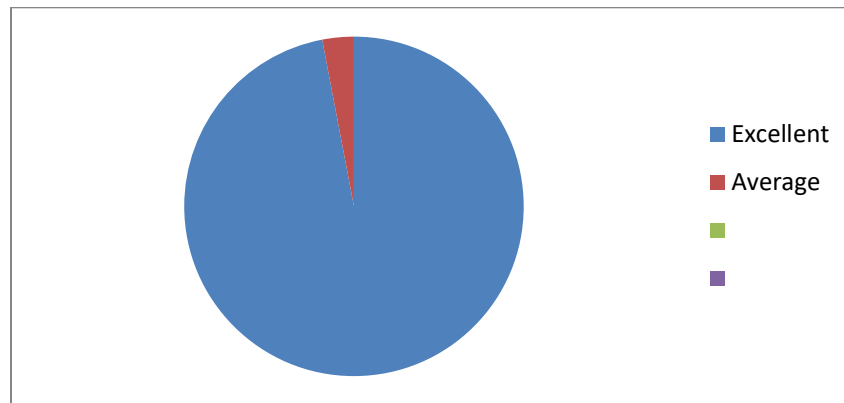

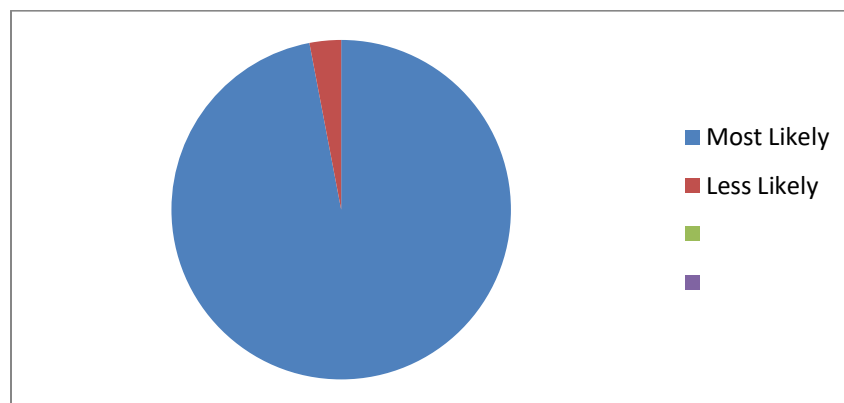
