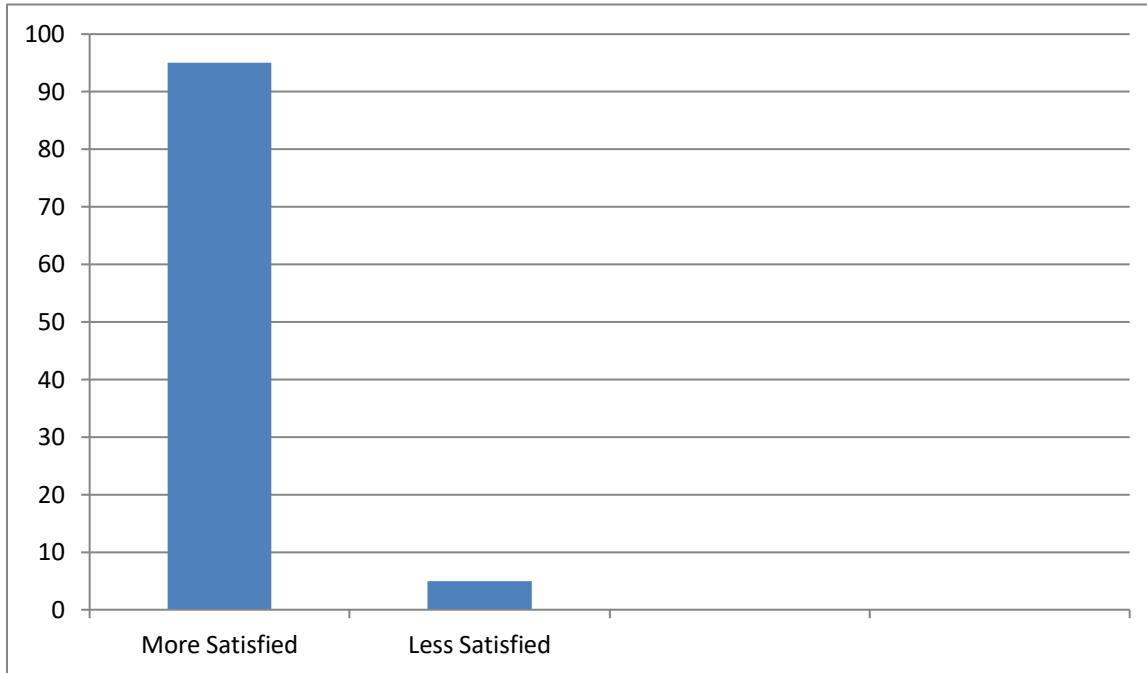




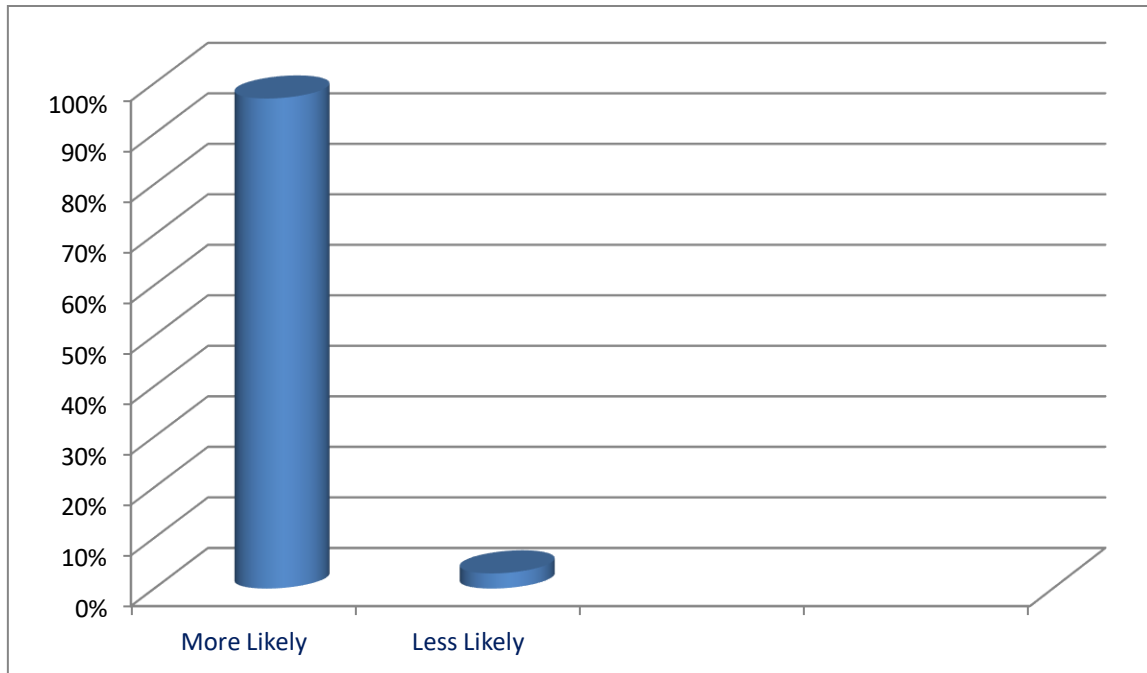

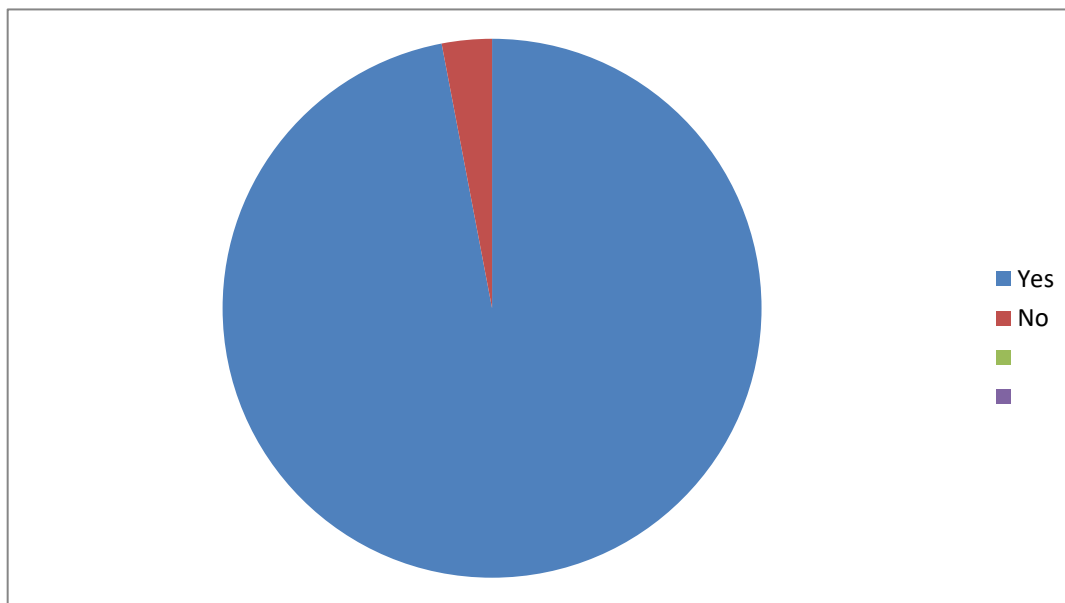
Feedback: All sessions and speakers were appreciated specially breast cancer treatment session along with Dr. M. M. Singh & Dr. Rahul Bansal session.

Feedback: All sessions were good and highly informative and enjoyed by the delegates.

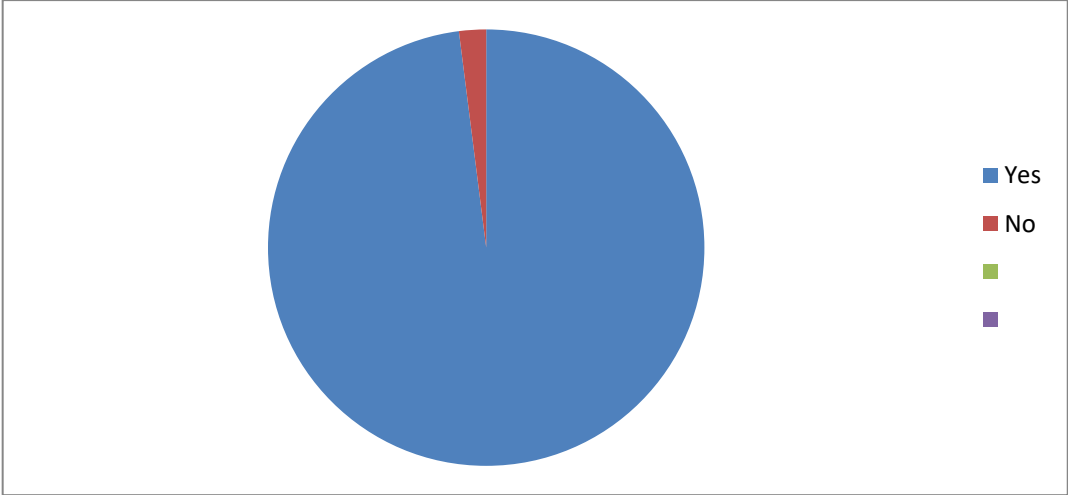

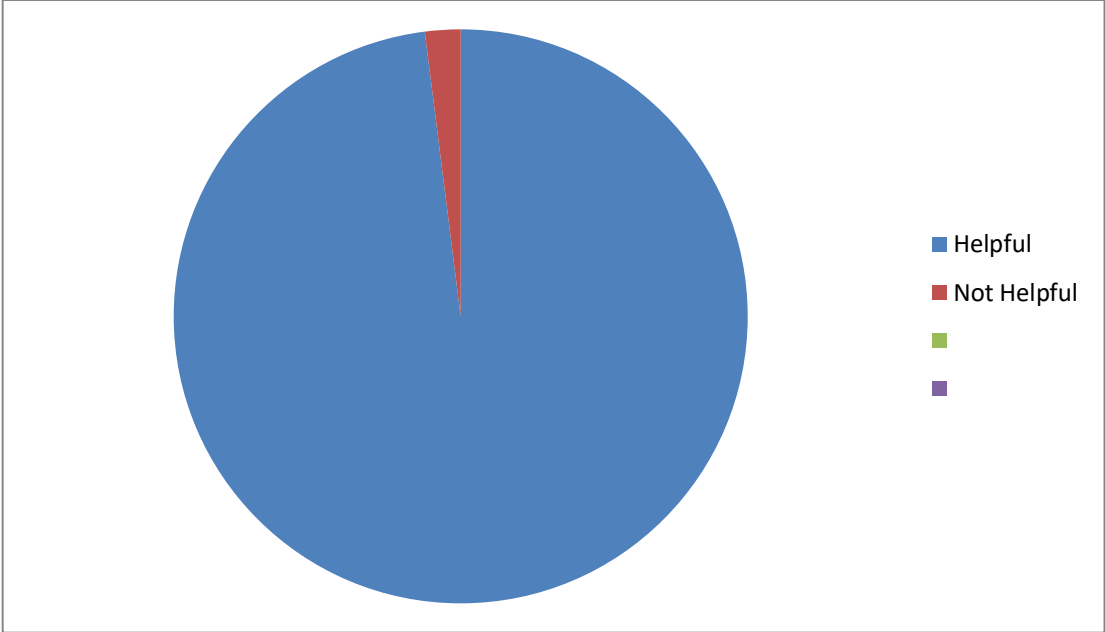

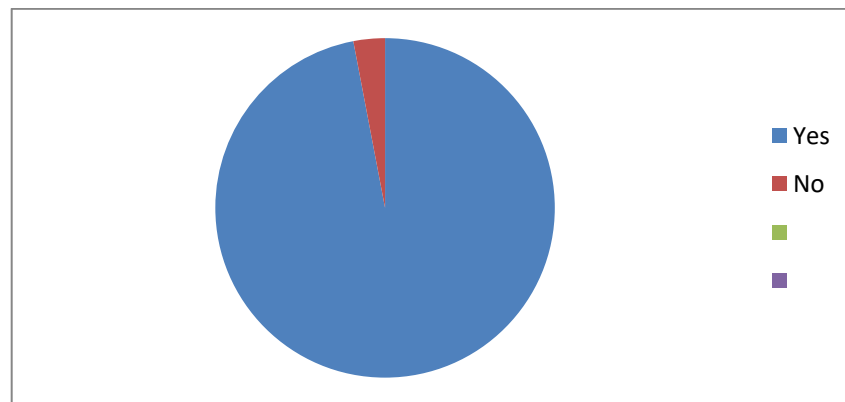

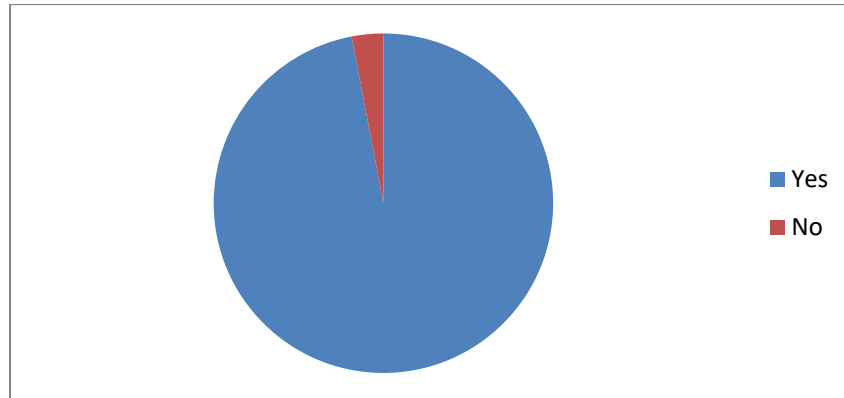

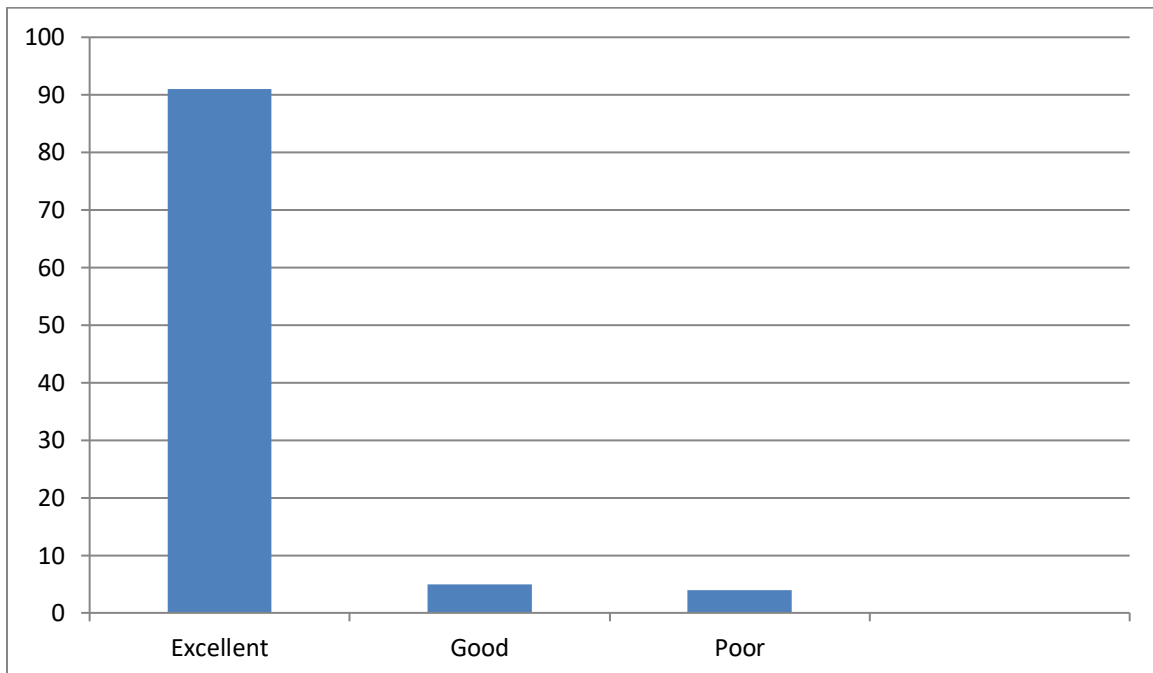

Feedback: Most delegates selected New Delhi as next location and some suggested Uttarakhand and Bihar also.

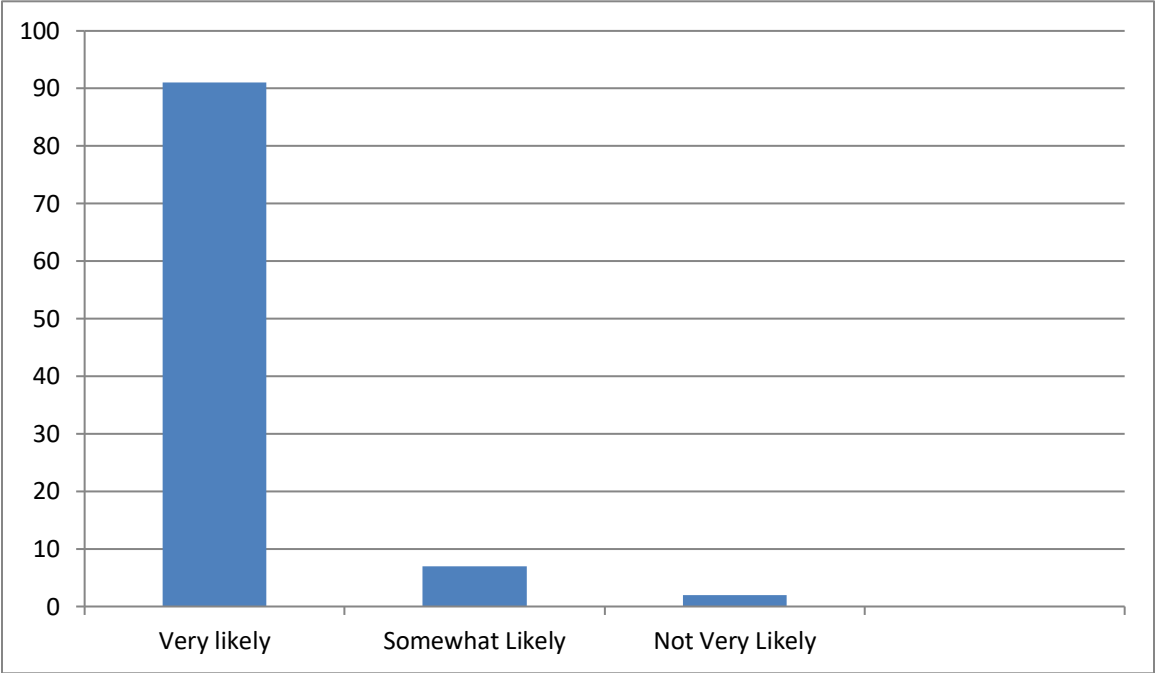

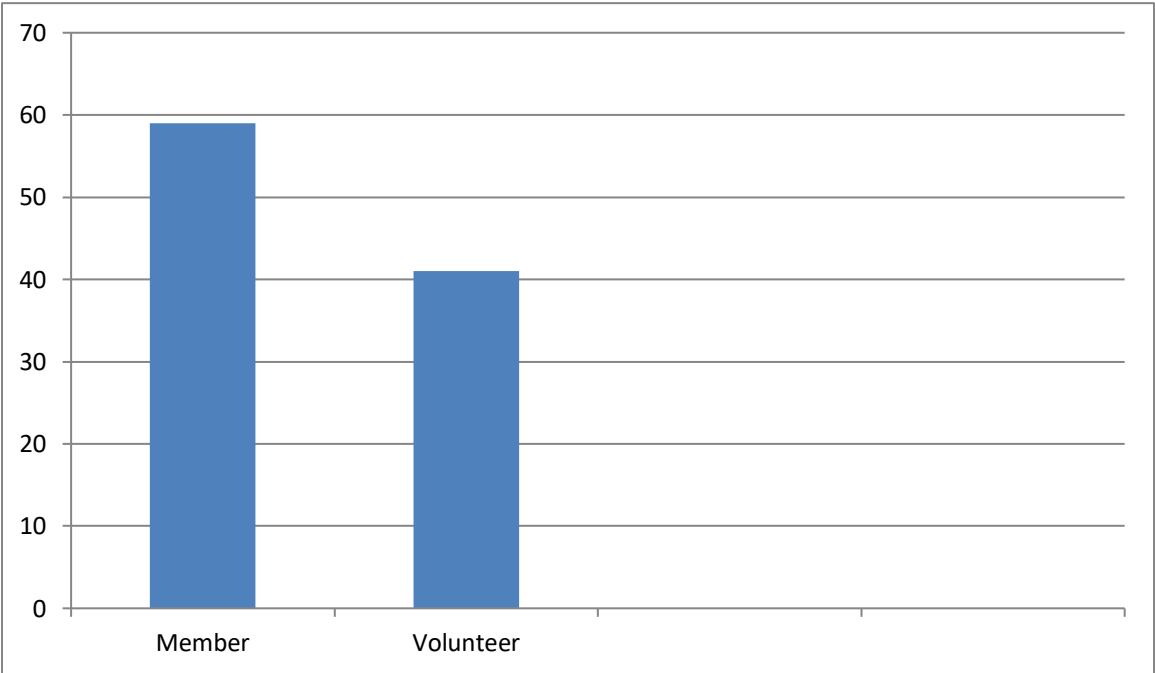
